


Cowichan Water Status

- Reduced from 15 CMS to 4.5 CMS by 1 CMS/day starting June 1
- No consensus
- River flow currently 4.5 CMS at weir, approx. 2.7 CMS below pump house
- Lake expected to reach 0 storage Aug. 8 without significant rainfall
- Pumping "negative storage" to begin then and extend until fall rains




Current and Forecast Lake Levels



Forecast Lake Levels


Figure 1 - Forecast Cowichan Lake Water Levels



Normal Zero Storage Level is the minimum lake level at which 7 m3/s can be maintained in Cowichan River Minimum Lake Level without pumping is the lowest lake level at which 4.5 m3/s can be maintained in Cowichan River without pumping Projected lake levels below the minimum assume pumping at a rate of 4.5 m3/s.
