





# Chemainus/Koksilah Rivers Twinned Watersheds Project





The Cowichan Watershed Board, Cowichan Tribes, and Halalt First Nation are underesearch in 2021 in the Koksilah and Chemainus Rivers. This is the first phase of a project. This project will gather flow and habitat data in the two rivers, map impovegetation areas, and interview indigenous knowledge holders.



Summary results will be publicly available and will provide communities and decision with information to better protect salmon and river ecosystems in the face of decisions summer water levels.
