Context


CWB is a unique organization!

- "purpose built" to support water/shed sustainability in the Cowichan/Koksilah Watershed
- Built on a foundational partnership between a local government (CVRD) and a First Nation – Cowichan Tribes
- A Board of Leaders elected or appointed by people who are elected – not a stakeholders table



Past "Visioning" work ...

- Grant from BC Freshwater Legacy Initiative in 2017-18 allowed us to organize 3 workshops to create a common vision for the CWB
- Workshop participants included CWB members, Senior staff from Cowichan Tribes and CVRD and external advisors
- Products included our Current Governance Manual & Pathways and Partnerships Framework



- Major outcomes:
 - Commitment at political level to work together towards water/shed sustainability – Nutsamat kws yaay'us tth qa'
 - Robust recognition statement and Hul'q'umi'num text and teachings in all documents

Shifting Landscape

- Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples ACT in BC
- Cowichan Water Use Plan
- CVRD Drinking Water and Watershed Protection Service
- Progress made on Koksilah WSP
- CWB Membership and Staff Changes
 - New Senior Staff in CT & CVRD
 - New members of CWB
 - Tom's role shifted to WSP and Weir
 - Lisa added as Business Manager
 - Leadership Team Model
