North Cowichan is hosting three community meetings to learn more about the 2025 budget and to hear feedback on municipal services and capital projects funded by property taxes, user fees and other revenue sources. Residents, businesses, and community groups are all invited to attend.

Starting with the first community meeting on Tuesday, November 26, department business plans will be presented to Council, outlining projects for next year and budget requests.

The meetings begin with an open house at 4:30pm, followed by a Special Committee of the Whole (presentation) at 6:00pm. All three meetings will have the same presentation.
